

I found most of the advice in here to be fairly useless, because it doesn't have a lot of modern (i.e., outside the traditional box) advice and the authors either barely acknowledge any of the differences in planning a Jewish wedding. Read Emily Post online for modern, up-to-date advice (the Emily Post wedding book is from 2005), and for Jewish wedding advice, go with Anite Diamant's The New Jewish Wedding.
